
Hillcrest Plans for the Future

Our family started visiting Hillcrest Baptist Church on Easter Sunday, March 27th, 2016. Eddie and I knew what


Everybody we were looking for in a knows what it is Church family for our family.

So, our journey began with Hillcrest Baptist Church. As weeks turned into months, we Amanda




as a family were gradually learning and involving ourselves into each activity we possibly could within the church. These included but were not lim-



35 Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. 36 When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. 37 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. 38 Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore to send out workers into his harvest field."


